Colorado Indigent Care Program (CICP)

- The CICP provides discounted healthcare services to low income individuals at participating providers.
- Qualifications include Colorado residence, meeting income and resource guidelines, and those ineligible for Medicaid and CHP+.
- Those covered by Medicare or who have other health insurance may be eligible for CICP.

Most people in Jefferson County apply for CICP through Stride, the first resource listed on this resource sheet.
