### Overview:

Colorado residents who meet the following criteria may be eligible for a PTC (Property Tax/Rent/Heat Credit) rebate. This rebate is available annually to those who qualify. Rent rebate amounts are based on an applicant's income and expenses.

### Eligibility:

- Resided in Colorado for the entire year
- Are lawfully present in the United States.
- 65 years of age or older, OR a surviving spouse 58 years or older, OR are disabled (no age requirement)
- You are not being claimed as a dependent on any other person's federal income tax return.
- income eligibility limits:
  - Single person: annual gross income less than \$15,831
  - Married couple: annual gross income less than \$21,381
