- Medicaid not accepted for outpatient therapy or med management but can be accepted for other services. Most insurance accepted.
- Hours of Operation: Monday – Friday, 8:00AM – 5:00PM. Treatment hours may differ.

- Drop-In Center @ CHARG
 - The drop-in center is open to anyone 18 years and older living with mental illness and receiving mental health treatment, regardless of where they receive treatment
 - One can sit quietly and read, or socialize in a variety of groups, recreational outings, and seasonal celebrations. Coffee, snacks, food bank, the daily newspaper, clothing bank, free internet and phone, and a low-cost lunch on Tuesdays (\$1.50).
 - Peer specialists are also available for assistance with basic needs resources.
 - Free of charge, but members must fill out a contact information form during first visit and bring verification of treatment to their second visit
 - Hours of Operation:
 - Monday, Wednesday, and Friday: 10am-5pm
 - Tuesday and Thursday: 12pm-5pm
 - Saturdays: 10am-2pm
- Heartland Clinic
 - Outpatient clinic that provides intensive services to adults with major mental illness.
 - These services include individual counseling, group counseling, medication management, case management, skills training, payee program, recreational activities, and monitoring of overall health.
