TYPES OF JOBS THAT OFTEN EMPLOY YOUTH (This is not an all-inclusive list)

City and county employment: Fill out and save application online. You can then apply for multiple jobs at once and create a Job Interest Card to receive email alerts when a job matching your criteria becomes available. Some positions that may hire youth would be concessions attendants, lifeguards, etc. Minimum age is 14 or 15, depending on position and municipality.
