Reminder - the meeting scheduled for tomorrow night, July 13, has been cancelled. The next scheduled meeting is for October 20.

A couple of updates.

Highway 40 resurfacing. I got this update from the CDOT Project Engineer from the Martin Marietta contact:

We completed the final stretch of paving to the top of the hill on Tuesday (July 6). We will finish paving the approaches tomorrow and Friday of this week (July 7&8). Approaches will start with Cabrini and we will work our way up from there. This will conclude paving/milling until the concrete drainage ditch is completed and we can finish up the work towards the bottom of the project.

ESI is continuing excavation and installation of the 18" RCP that runs under the access road to the Hotel and gas station. As long as they continue to avoid large amounts of Rock Excavation, they should make short work of it. Once that is finished, they can form and pour their inlets. After the inlet pours and backfill, they can start shaping the concrete ditch for Lobato.

Adarand will start guardrail tomorrow at Lookout Mountain Rd and work their way down the hill. They will complete the 4 smaller sections of guardrail first and then start on the long section running eastbound starting at the Park N Ride at Exit 256. We expect to set the Safety Critical portion of the project starting on the 26th of July. This will consist of 6 nights of a single lane closure on I70 westbound to set concrete barriers on the shoulder of the interstate to protect I70 from falling debris while installing guardrail during the day.

So the resurfacing project is finished. There will still be some lane closures as old guard rail is removed and 3 foot guard rail is installed. Work will continue at the bottom of Hwy 40 and then resurfacing will proceed after the drainage work is complete.
